This letter will provide information regarding the required materials for application and provide resources to learn more about our program.

The deadline for applications is September 15th for the next academic year. Late applications will be considered if any remaining positions are available. We encourage you to submit a completed application as soon as possible. The required documentation listed below must be completed and submitted before an interview will be granted.

1. A complete AOA application for post graduate education.
2. Three letters of recommendation from physicians who have observed you during your internal medicine training or clinical practice.
3. A letter of recommendation from your program director(s).
4. A copy of your current medical license to practice.
5. A copy of part I, II and III and COMLEX or USMLE board scores.
6. An official osteopathic medical school transcript to include GPA & Class Rank
7. A personal statement regarding your interest in cardiology.
8. A document that includes a return address for regular mail, an e-mail address, phone numbers to contact you, your AOA number and social security number. Also include your current status in training or practice.
9. A passport size picture.
